Southern Virginia University is nearing completion of their new athletic facility, a multi-phase project designed by Civil Consulting Group in 2008 and 2009.

Two full-size fields and one multi-use field are located north of SVU's new dormitory. The complex will be used for soccer, football, and lacrosse with room to add tennis and other sports. The largest field will be topped with artificial turf. The facility is being constructed by Pearson Construction of Dillwyn and will open this spring.

## Public-Private Partnerships & Community Involvement

CCG recently oversaw the four-way partnership between the City of Buena Vista, Southern Virginia University, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and Palmyra Holdings, LLC. The partnership made it possible to enhance fire protection capabilities and increase water pressure for residences in northeast Buena Vista.

Botetourt County has nominated and selected Hunter Young, of CCG, to serve on the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy Committee

(CEDS) for the Roanoke Valley and Allegheny Regions. Hunter is one of two private-sector business leaders chosen to represent the County.

The purpose of CEDS is to unite the public and private sectors in the creation of an economic road map to diversify and strengthen regional economies. Projects with the potential to increase economic development are recommended through the Council for Federal grant money.

## Recent Projects

Civil Consulting Group worked with local governments, educational institutions, and private developers to provide civil engineering services throughout the year, including:

- **Southern Virginia University Athletic Facility, Buena Vista, VA**  
Civil engineering and site development plan for a phased, 50-acre athletic facility with three fields and room for future planned expansion.
- **Dinky Trail Waterline, Buena Vista, VA**  
Design of 3,000 linear feet of 8" diameter waterline to expand a pressure zone to serve new institutional development and to enhance fire protection.
- **North River Sewer Bypass Line, Harrisonburg, VA**  
Design of a 36" diameter, 30 million-gallon-per-day temporary sewer bypass line to support the construction of a new wastewater treatment facility.
- **Shoppes at Sunset Cay, Moneta, VA**  
Grading plan and stormwater management / water quality improvement design for a three-acre retail center near Smith Mountain Lake.
- **Greenfield Athletic Facility Concession Area, Botetourt County, VA**  
Layout and grading for a new 100-space parking lot with stormwater and water quality improvements along with irrigation, potable water, and sanitary sewer to serve several existing sports/recreation areas.
- **Stormwater Management and Best Management Practices, Buena Vista, VA**  
Design of an underground stormwater detention system and water quality improvement structures to serve a new townhome development.
- **Marina at Sunset Cay Stormwater Management, Moneta, VA**  
Comprehensive stormwater management design and water quality plan for a 47-acre, mixed-use development along Smith Mountain Lake.
- **On-Call Contracts with Botetourt and Roanoke Counties, VA**
